- Procuring and training volunteers that we may expand our programs
- Launch After School Care in English Oaks in the fall

(1) On your device, navigate to cmalliance.org/give (2) Scroll down to "International Workers and Special Projects" (3) In the Search field, enter GROS and click the red "support" button under our name (4) Enter the amount of your gift (5) Indicate "recurring" and select the date to give each month (6) Set up your MyCMA to manage your giving (7) Remember to link your giving to the Alliance Missions giving of your church.

- Refugee kids improving in their school work and academic skills
- Refugee kids being better prepared for life in America
- Kids, who have little or no knowledge of Jesus/God's word/salvation, coming to know God, love him, serve him and glorify him (Parents too)
- Kids, who come from countries closed to the gospel, grow into adults, and as God leads them, return to their home countries to share the gospel
- The multiplication of ministries in various apartment complexes and in the Greater Atlanta area
- The training of church people to both receive and to minister to their own neighborhoods, as well as to neighboring ethnic groups
- Christ-followers answering the call to ministry to "Judea, Samaria, and to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8)
- Treasure for yourselves stored up in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal (Matthew 6:20)
