### PACKING CHECKLIST FOR GIRLS AGES 5-9 AS FOLLOWS:

- **Purchase items** - Toys, Hygiene items, School Supplies, etc.
- **Pack** - Remove items from packaging and pack into shoebox.
- **Personalize** - Include a letter to recipient and a photo of your family.
- **Prepare \$9 Donation** - donate on line ([samaritanspurse.org/occ](http://samaritanspurse.org/occ)) you can track your box. This supports project costs, transportation & gospel materials.
- **Pray** - Lift up in prayer the shoebox journey and the child receiving the gift.

Doll (Consider including accessories such as doll clothes or a small doll bed.), Stuffed animal  
Small musical instrument (such as a harmonica or recorder)  
Comb, Hairbrush, hair bows, friendship bracelet, Compact mirror  
Toothbrush, Non-liquid lip balm  
Washcloth, Bar soap (packaged and/or in a container)  
Adhesive bandages (Colorful ones can help a child be more willing to wear a bandage. Do not include liquid antibiotic ointment.)  
Reusable plastic containers: cup, water bottle, plate, bowl, blunt-edged utensils (Consider filling an empty container with non-liquid items such as hair bows, bracelets, sunglasses, or washcloths to maximize the space.)  
Non-liquid lip balm  
Colored pencils, Pencils & Small manual pencil sharpener  
Pencil case, Pens, Crayons, Markers  
Small Notebooks, small adhesive tape  
Safety Scissors, Glue stick (do not include liquid glue)  
Pillowcase dress (loose-fitting sundress)
