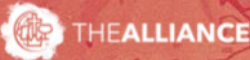

This is what occurred because you cared, because you prayed and because you contributed financially to help send me to Dakar, Senegal, Africa last spring. I couldn't be there without all of you, which means that you are part of the success of my mission over the 4 weeks I was there. Because you supported me in the Spring, I was asked to return to Sierra Leone in the fall because they did not have enough O.R. nurses.

Thanks to all of you...

- more than 46 people have regained their sight after having cataract surgery or pterygium (growth) removed...routine here, rare there
- more than 40 kids had their hernia repaired along with other associated procedures... routine here, rare there
- over 25 people had huge tumors removed from their mouth/jaw/face area...doesn't happen here, many there
- 10 patients, often children, had terrible burn scars released so that they could use their arms/legs/etc freely again
- 6 kids with gigantism were able to have surgery to help them have a more normal childhood
- several kids are able to use their hands and feet normally after having surgeries to remove birth defects
- 5 women had breast lumps removed, 17 had large fatty tumors removed from various body parts
- 5 kids with noma had the next stage of their treatment accomplished, with more to come...we don't have this here, deadly there
- 3 had the next stage of their cleft palate surgery
- 2 had the next stage of their operation to allow them to walk with straight legs

And more...you are part of each surgery that I was a part of. You are part of each surgery that happened because I was part of another one so other teams could do their part as well. Thank you all for being in this journey with me.
