BAPTISM

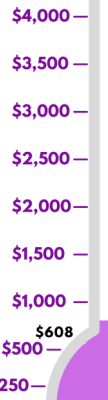
Please see Pastor Jones if you are considering baptism for the April 20th Resurrection Sunday service.
