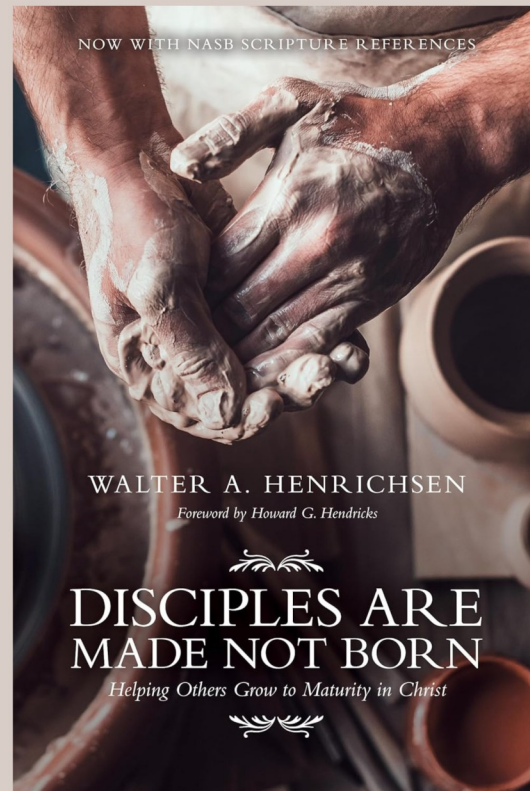

- **MONDAY:** Write out the given verse(s).
- **TUESDAY:** Write them in at least two other translations.
- **WEDNESDAY:** Circle key words to look up in the original languages and write down the definitions, synonyms, and root words.
- **THURSDAY:** Explore the meaning and message of the verse or verses. Consider the people, places, and context involved, and make connections to other relevant passages and concepts in Scripture.
- **FRIDAY:** Write a 1-2 sentence summary of what you learned and consider how you can apply it.
- **SATURDAY:** Use Saturday to catch up if you missed a day.
