GOSPEL LANGUAGE

Our Roma congregation at a church in eastern Kosovo has been full of challenges the last couple of years, but in April we got to celebrate the publishing of the New Testament in the dialect that our Roma people speak! Through a contact in Serbia, we were able to get about 200 copies to use here in Kosovo. We've been able to give them out to congregants, use copies in our services, and share copies with other churches. While many Roma can't read or write, it's very exciting to see those who can hold a Bible for the first time and read aloud from it!

Please continue to pray for those who attend as most of them have not yet put their faith in Christ. And pray for us as we seek to love and proclaim truth to this marginalized population.

At least twice a year, the leaders of our local partner church network gather to spend time together in worship, prayer, sharing, and discussing ministry. This time, the church in eastern Kosovo hosted the meeting. The network has continued to grow, and we can now barely fit everyone in our meeting room! It was a good day together; however, this has been a discouraging season of ministry for many of the leaders and the churches overall. Would you pray for encouragement for these leaders as well as

spiritual breakthroughs in Kosovo? There are plenty of challenges mounted against us, but we press on in faith knowing that Christ is greater than all of them!

Praises:

- For the youth of the local church network to continue to grow in their faith and ways they serve the Lord!
- For fruitful conversations in some of the difficult situations I have been dealing with.
- For a good week of leadership training in Idaho—both encouraged me and gave me new tools for this phase of ministry.

Please pray:

- That a discipleship conference for believers from a Muslim background would help believers in Kosovo go deeper in their faith and be set free from the spiritual bondage from their past.
- That the Lord would help me in preparing a series of messages and devotionals for a young adult camp in Kosovo in July.
- That the youth committee of the Kosovo Protestant Evangelical Church would receive a grant I have been helping them apply for through the European Evangelical Alliance.
